Every zombie has a complete outfit and props - trailing entrails, distressingly cute rats, hatchets, hats and mouldy frockcoats add to their individuality. They're fast to make too, so if you want to go for the full cast, you can have hours of family fun taking them apart and putting them together in increasingly incongruous mixtures. Truly, the undead have never looked so appealing.
